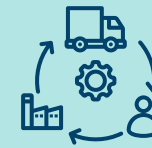

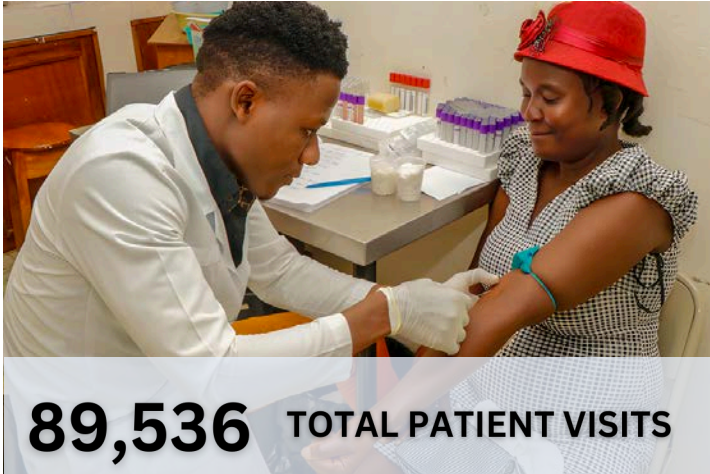

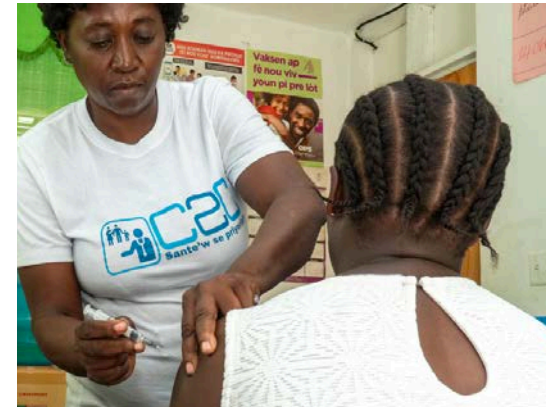

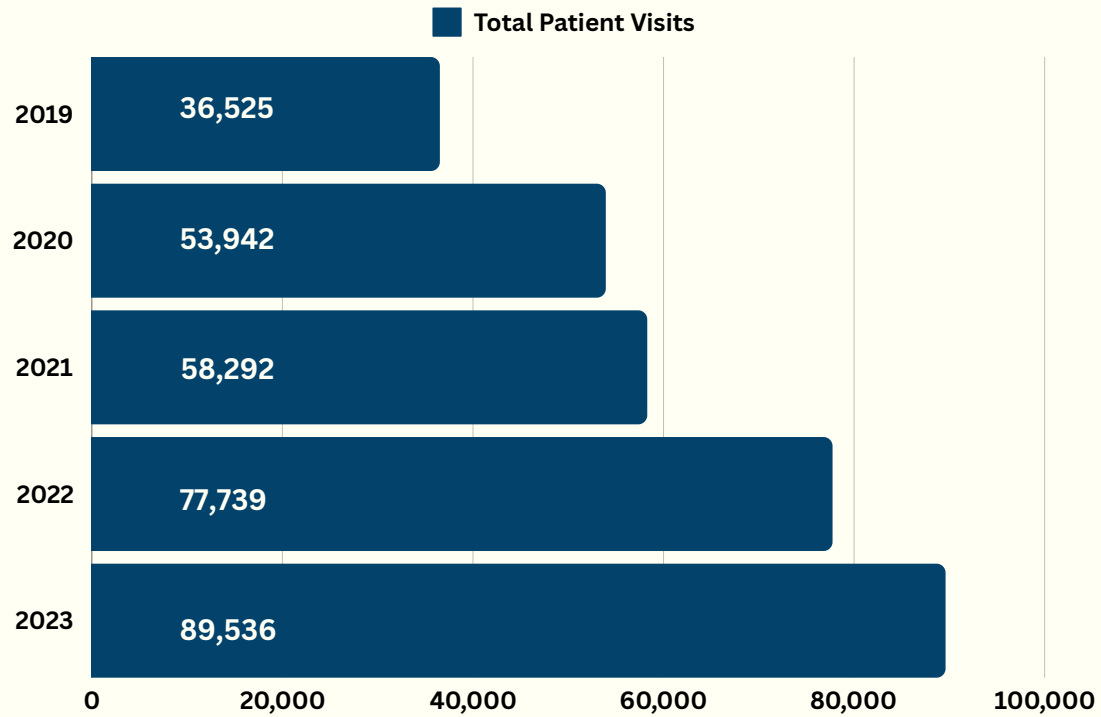

TECHNOLOGY-ENABLED HEALTHCARE

We've achieved a remarkable milestone in Haiti by deploying an Electronic Medical Records (EMR) system, overcoming the widespread challenge of unstable internet connectivity. By leveraging Starlink technology, we ensure uninterrupted services, significantly enhancing patient care quality and precision in medical data management in an environment where such advancements are challenging and critically important. In 2023, we finished implementing the EMR system across our seven-clinic network, successfully training 78 employees, resulting in streamlined patient data management and enhanced care coordination.



MATERNAL HEALTH EXPANSION

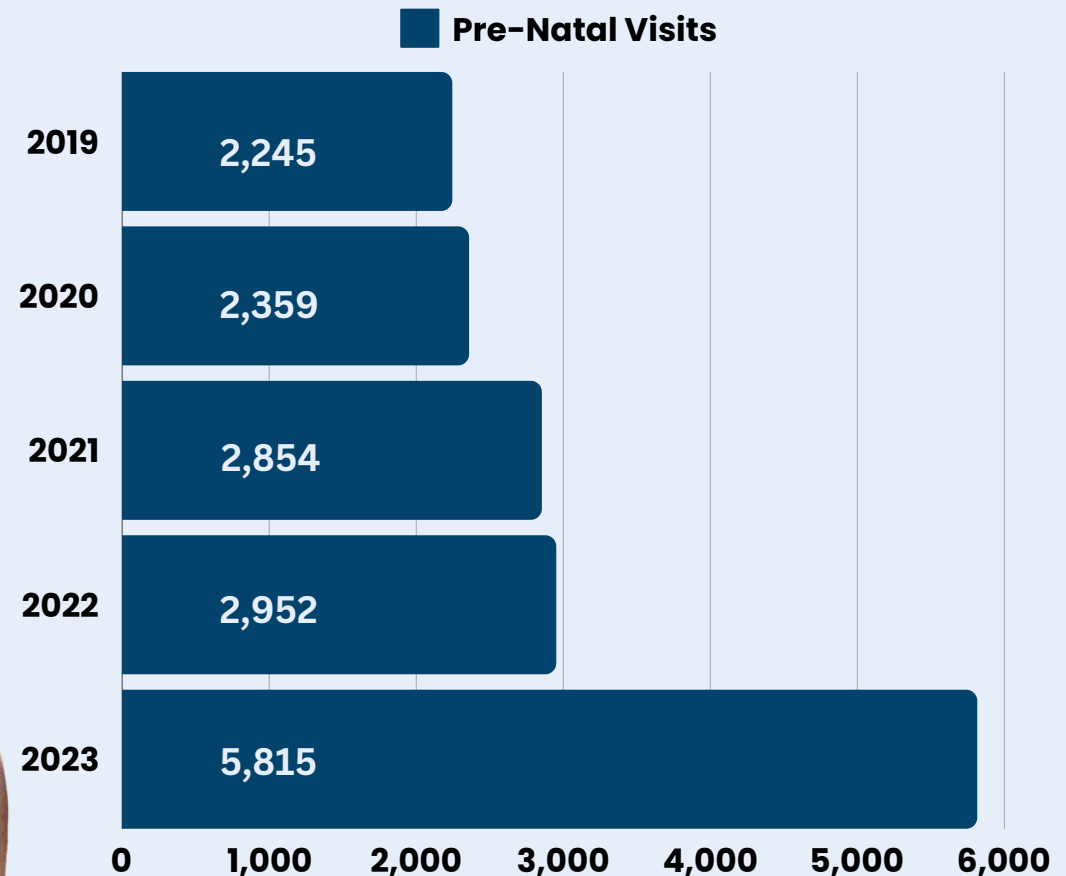
In 2023, under the guidance of a midwife and a women-led team, we expanded our reach to include two additional clinics in Bas-Limbe and Roche-Plate. We hired five highly trained maternal and pediatric nurses who, under obstetrician-gynecologist guidance, completed a six-month program to master and interpret obstetric ultrasounds. We've enhanced our team with three new HIV counseling nurses and focused on training staff, equipping them to provide and expand our HIV testing program.

Meet Dieuveula

Dieuveula, from Massabiel, Haiti, faced significant challenges in motherhood, including stillbirth and complications during home deliveries. During her fifth pregnancy, she learned about C2C when a community health agent came to her village. During her maternal health consultation at a C2C clinic, she received laboratory testing, which revealed she had moderate malnutrition and anemia. She visited the clinic throughout her pregnancy until heavy rainfall flooded the roadways one day, making transportation to the clinic impossible. But that didn't stop the C2C community health agent from reaching her.

“The most surprising thing is that the road leading to my house was almost inaccessible after the heavy rains. But the C2C health worker found me. I couldn't believe my eyes. He reminded me of my new consultation date, checked the progress of my weight, and asked me not to miss my next ultrasound. It was so touching.”

- **MATERNAL HEALTH EXPANSION:** Enhanced services from pregnancy to postnatal care for optimal mother-infant health
- **SEXUAL REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH EDUCATION COLLABORATION:** Integrated Sexual Reproductive Health education into the classroom and incorporated boys and girls into the same class
- **Quality Control Commitment:** Rigorous standards maintained across all services and programs, including more chart reviews in 2023

In 2024, we are committed to reaching more patients and enhancing healthcare delivery. Some of our goals include:

- **EXPAND OUR COMMUNITY HEALTH PROGRAM** to reach more individuals and families in our catchment area.
- **EXPAND MATERNAL HEALTH** into our seven-clinic network while promoting the program across communities.
- **STRENGTHEN PROGRAM LEADERSHIP** by hiring a Community Health Supervisor and Sexual Reproductive Health Education Supervisor.
- **ELEVATE TECHNOLOGY-DRIVEN HEALTHCARE** by offering staff training thereby enhancing patient care and service efficiency.

Leaders in Excellence

In 2023, we welcomed Dr. Inobert Pierre and Christie-Anne Michel to our team. Together, they have transformed our programs and achieved outstanding results.

Dr. Inobert Pierre is our Chief Program Officer. He hails from Limbe in Northern Haiti and completed his medical education in Port-au-Prince. With 23 years of medical experience, he spent the last 20 years in various roles at Health Equity International/St-Boniface Hospital.

Christie-Anne Michel is our Program Manager. She grew up in Cap-Haïtien and studied nursing at the State University of Haiti's nursing faculty before specializing in community health in Port-au-Prince. She has focused on primary care and HIV care and served as the program manager at the Center Médico-Social de La Fossette.



RESIDENCY PROGRAM AT C2C

Doctors, nurses, and laboratory technicians undergo a comprehensive one-year residency following their academic training. Our experienced management team provides them with dedicated coaching, mentoring, and supervision during this period, ensuring high professional development.

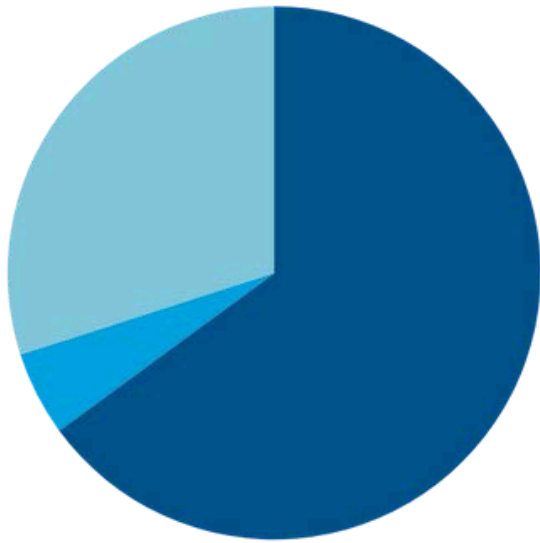

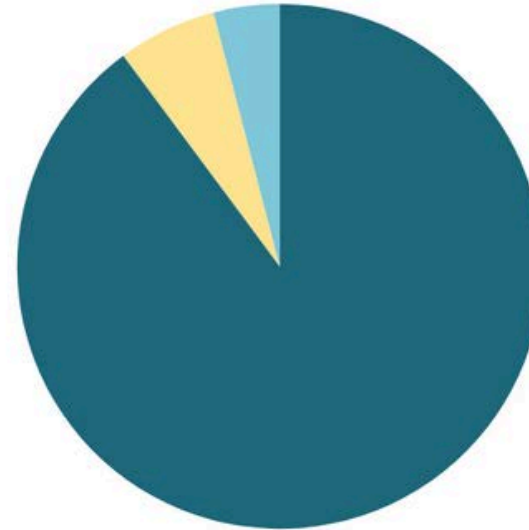
